

















# Chaplain - Ben Madigan



# **Safety & Education - Dusty Dibler**

#### SADDLE UP,

t's that time of the year to wipe the dust off our babies and start riding, but do you know the T-CLOCK CHECK LIST? Let me inform you of what it is.

T = Tires & wheels: It's more than just checking the cold tire pressure and tread depth, it's also checking the spokes, rims, bearings and seals.

C = Controls: Check your levers, cables, hoses, and throttle.

L = Lights: Check your lenses, headlamp, reflectors, battery and wiring.

O = Oil: Check all levels of fluid and look for any leaks that might have popped up over the winter.

C = Chassis: Check the front forks, shocks, frame, and chain or belt drive.

K = Kickstand: Yes kickstand! Check the spring tension and tightness.

It's recommended to do the T-CLOCK every time before you ride.




