





DID YOU KNOW? STAY INFORMED!

In May, the Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) submitted comments to the U.S. Department of Transportation as part of the Trump Administration's executive order regarding efficiency and deregulation. The attack on the Internal Combustion Engine is occurring in three ways. First through emissions regulations issued by the Environmental Protection Agency, second through the power of the California Air Resources Board and finally through increased fuel economy standards issued by NHSTA. Our comments in this submission related only to NHTSA's new fuel standards as that is where the DOT's jurisdiction exists.

Four concerns the MRF has with the new fuel economy standards which would threaten the Internal Combustion Engine are:

- Reduced availability of affordable support technologies and fuels for motorcycle riders
- Distorted market dynamics and limited consumer choice
- Decreased relevance and impact of the aftermarket parts industry
- Rural motorcyclists will be disproportionately impacted due to insufficient infrastructure

We also offered three actions the DOT could take.

- Repeal or rollback of the 53.5 mpg target
- Consideration of non-EV pathways to efficiency that respect consumer diversity
- Protections for ICE technology development that support the motorcycling community







Tire Rack Street Survival provides:

- Trained and qualified in-car driving instructors as well as classroom experience for each student.
- Hands-on educational driving experience in real-world situations, teaching teens car safety and control in their own vehicles.
- Challenging driving situations, including skid control and emergency lane change on private courses, allowing students to experience abnormal

vehicle behavior in a safe and supervised environment.

Six teens ages 16-19 die every day from motor vehicle iniuries.

How much does it cost?

\$125 per student.

Why do I use my own vehicle?


We ask that students use the vehicles they normally drive. Our goal is to teach students how their vehicles react under different driving conditions. Each vehicle has unique handling characteristics — for example, front-wheel-drive versus rear-wheel-drive — and we want students to be comfortable in the vehicle where they spend most of their time. Students should use their daily driver, or the family vehicle, for the driving exercises.

How long does the school last?

The one-day program is a mixture of classroom and hands-on exercises with instructors in the vehicles with the students. In the classroom they learn about proper seating and hand positions, mirror placement, the concept of the cantact patch of their tires, the theories of weight transfer, and the use of long distance vision and situational awareness. Then the students are put through a series of exercises that are based on real-world situations. The students learn

skid control on a wet skid pad; go through lane change and accident avoidance maneuvers; do braking exercises; and they drive a slalom course to learn about weight transfer. The challenges of driver distractions — such as the radio or navigation systems, cell phones for talking, texting, or selfies; and the significant effect of too many other teens riding with them — are emphasized.

62% of teenage passenger deaths occurred in vehicles driven by another teenager.



Students must have an unrestricted driver's license (i.e., not being held by authorities) or permit. If the driver has a permit, that permit must be held for half the time required by the

state having jurisdiction, plus a minimum of 25 hours driving experience.

- If under 18, students must have their parents' permission to participate in the Tire Rack Street Survival school., and parents must sign the Minor Waiver.
- Parents are encouraged to attend and participate in the classroom sessions with their teens. They will see the program firsthand, and perhaps learn valuable information themselves!
- Students must present a photocopy of their license, proof of insurance, and the original signed Minor Waiver form (if under 18) to participate in Street Survival schools.


