What does A.B.A.T.E. do?

- Protects the rights and freedoms of motorcyclist and off-road riders in Illinois, ensuring they are not restricted by unnecessary legislation.
- Advocates for freedom of choice, especially regarding motorcycle related regulations such as gear requirements and riding practices.
- Actively works with state and local legislators to ensure motorcyclists' voices are included in transportation planning and policymaking.
- Serves as a legislation watchdog, monitoring and influencing legislative actions that affect motorcycle rights on the state, national, and even global levels.
- Helps draft motorcycle-related legislation that improves rider safety and protects motorcyclist rights throughout Illinois.
- Conducts extensive safety and education programs for drivers, seniors, legislators, and motorcyclists to increase awareness and reduce accidents.
- Promotes motorcycle safety, acceptance, and enjoyment through statewide educational and community outreach programs.
- Provides discounted legal services to members, offering support for injury cases, wills, and other legal needs through experienced motorcycle rights attorneys.
- Maintains a strong statewide network of more than 60 chapters and over 120,000 members, allowing broad grassroots action and community involvement.
- Organizes advocacy events and rallies, such as Freedom Rallies and Legislative Days, giving riders direct access to lawmakers.
- Publishes newsletters and informational materials to keep riders informed about rights issues, laws, events, and safety education.
- Employs a professional lobbyist to represent motorcycle rights in Springfield, ensuring continuous advocacy in government.

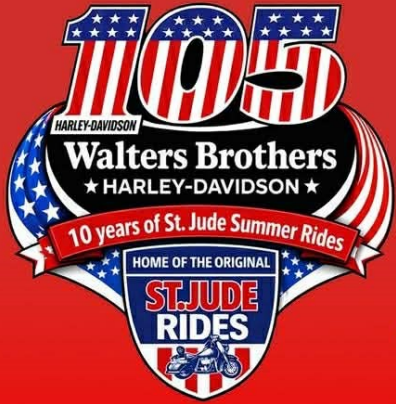

DID YOU KNOW? STAY INFORMED FROM THE MOTORCYCLE RIDERS FOUNDATION (MRF)!

The Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) has two critical bills pending before the United States House of Representatives – H.R. 3385 (definition of a motorcycle) and H.R. 1566 (right to repair and modify) -- along with the pending draft of the Highway Funding Bill.

Time is not on our side. We have work to do, and nothing says “Get ‘er done” like showing up in person at Bikers Inside the Beltway. Yes, you can meet with your members of Congress in their home districts. Yes, you can send an email. But emails and district visits alone will not move the needle fast enough. Answering the call and showing up in Washington -- in person -- is how we ensure our legislative priorities are included in the Highway Bill before the window closes.

The Capitol campus is massive. A typical day is 8–12 miles when the mission is to visit all 535 congressional offices and leave behind our position papers. It's demanding. It's exhausting. And it is absolutely necessary if we expect our message to break through the noise.

We've all seen groups visit Capitol Hill for photo ops, dinners, and tours. That's not what the MRF does. The MRF, alongside our partner SMROs and sustaining motorcycle clubs, shows up to work -- strategically, deliberately, and relentlessly.

For nearly two decades, Bikers Inside the Beltway has been the front line of legislative advocacy. Our successes happened because bikers showed up, walked the miles, and made it clear to members of Congress that motorcycling is more than a stereotype on a television screen.

The MRF is serious about protecting the rights of all motorcyclists -- and protecting our rights requires action, not just conversation. Make your reservations. Schedule your appointments with your representatives. Show up ready to walk.

“Motorcycle Awareness Month - A National Recognition Of Riders And Road Safety”

Each May, communities across the country come together to recognize Motorcycle Awareness Month, a time dedicated to promoting safety, awareness and respect for motorcyclists on America’s roadways. From city halls to state capitols and even the halls of the U.S. Congress, elected officials are once again passing resolutions that celebrate the contributions of motorcyclists and call attention to the importance of sharing the road.

Throughout the nation, local and state governments are adopting proclamations that highlight the freedom and community that motorcycling represents, while also emphasizing the responsibility all road users share in preventing crashes. At the federal level, members of Congress continue this tradition by introducing and supporting resolutions that recognize the millions of Americans who ride and the organizations that advocate on their behalf

As proclamations are signed and resolutions are adopted, Motorcycle Awareness Month serves as both a celebration and a call to action. Motorists are reminded to remain vigilant, give riders a second look and understand that motorcycles are an integral part of the transportation landscape.

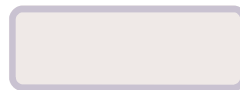
