

**NUMBERS SPEAK VOLUMES!!!** 







Hello Everyone,

I'd like to start off by saying Thank You Nick for getting our newsletter back up and running. I'd also like to thank everyone who showed up and helped staple and fold our newsletter.

As you all know we are no different than any other organization, we are losing membership and getting little help from our membership. Our sponsorship is down as well. So, if you enjoy your rights to ride the way you want to ride and what you ride, I strongly suggest you go to Legislative day on March 19th, 2025. Our lovely politicians up north are still pushing a helmets law, loud pipes law and loud music law and they have the support from SIU, who is supposably in charge of motorcycle safety class courses. 


