












This park is great for all ages and drivers with a few trails and a variety of terrain. They rent out helmets and flags

Fox Valley Off Road

Hours of Operation: Weekends 10-4

Location: 1952 N 35th Road, Ottowa, IL 61530

Cost of Admission: \$20 per day. Kids under 12: \$10

Types of Vehicles allowed: Motorcycles & ATVs only

This park is open to motorcycles and ATVs only, but the staff is very flexible with large groups that want to ride on a

weekday as long as you set an appointment.
