Peo-Taz Chapter of A.B.A.T.E. of Illinois Job Description Safety & Ed Coordinator

QUALIFICATIONS

As the person responsible for safety and education matters in the Chapter and the community, the Safety & Ed Coordinator must be a person of integrity who is organized and in public relations activities can communicate well with school administrators, teachers, and students.

TIME REQUIRED

The Safety & Ed Coordinator will need to devote approximately 30-40 hours per month to the job for telephone\computer and paperwork, preparation of the programs, and presentations of the programs. Each month there is an Officers meeting and a Chapter meeting.

BASIC DUTIES INCLUDE:

- Contacting all high schools in Peoria and Tazewell counties, as well as schools in surrounding communities as requested, to set up schedules for classroom presentations.
- 2. Coordinate with other Safety & Ed Coordinators of local chapters to eliminate duplicity.
- 3. Reporting activities of the office at the Officers meeting.
- 4. Casting one vote on issues before the Officers or Chapter meetings.
- 5. Sending in reports and required paperwork to State.
- 6. Recruiting and training volunteers as instructors and workers for classroom presentations.
- 7. Scheduling instructors and workers for each school presentation.
- 8. Acquiring reports after each school presentation and providing statistics to the State A.B.A.T.E. Safety & Education Coordinator by the end of each month.
- Being involved in, encouraging, other Chapter activities such as non-alcohol poker runs, CPR classes for Chapter members, presentations at senior citizen centers and church meetings and any other activity which would promote the safety and education program.
- Setting the date, promoting, and providing a signup sheet for the Experienced Rider Course on an annual basis.
- 11. Preparing an article for the monthly Chapter newsletter.
- 12. Maintaining inventory related Safety & Ed Supplies for job performance.
- 13. Performing other duties as requested by the Executive Board.
